



Dr Dragana Nikitovic is a faculty member at the Laboratory of Histology-Embryology, School of Medicine, University of Crete in Heraklion She graduated from the Faculty of Natural Sciences, University of Belgrade, obtaining the title of B.Sc in Biochemistry.
